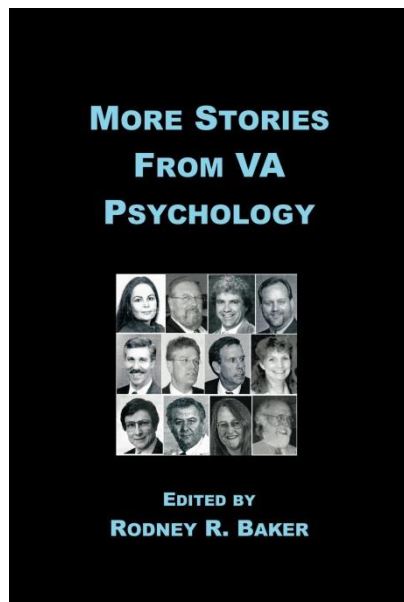


# More Stories From VA Psychology

## About the Book



*More Stories From VA Psychology* follows the format of the first stories book, *Stories From VA Psychology* (see bottom of page). Twelve former and current psychology leaders in the Veterans Administration/Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) describe their leadership careers and the people and events that shaped their career decisions in working with veterans. In doing so, their stories expand the understanding of the formal history of the role of VA psychologists in helping veterans over the years.

The careers of the chapter authors and their stories collectively span 61 of the 66 years of VA psychology history that began in 1946. Some of the careers include descriptions of experiences as a trainee in the early and later years of the VA psychology training program. Some contain stories about research projects, treatment programs, and advocacy efforts as these leaders worked with colleagues they admired and respected in serving veterans. A brief description of the VA careers of chapter authors and the editor completes the book.

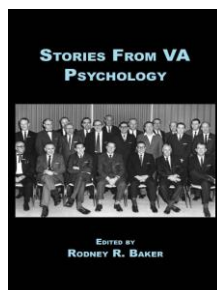
